


Empathize

Identity




Fill in each section of the wheel with an identity of yours.

Put a red dot in the areas that you think about most often in your everyday life.


Put a yellow dot in the areas you don't think of often in your everyday life.

Put a blue dot in the areas that have the biggest impact on how others perceive you.


Values

Identifying my community


For each identity we have, we belong to a community of people who have similar identities.



For each identity you selected, describe what community you belong to.


My community's values

The values we have because of our identities are also probably held by other members of our communities.


